Although each escrow is different, below is a list of some general items needed by your escrow company during your transaction.

 Copy of the fully executed purchase agreement along with any addendums or counter offers Both real estate agents contact information. Along with each agent's commission percentage to be paid per side. 	 Tax forms provided by Escrow Holder to be completed and returned. Escrow will enclose forms such as the "FIRPTA", 1099 and 593C form as part of the opening package. Mailing instructions for any documents, checks etc. that may need to be sent to the Seller after
 Payoff information if any such as liens, existing loans, judgments and homeowners' association fees that may be due. 	 close of escrow. Original Grant Deed Approved estimated HUD-1 or Good
 Homeowners Association Information if any. 	Faith Estimate of closing costs prior to the close of escrow.
